Students must attend an accredited institution on a full-time basis and major or minor in art, drafting, or related fields. Individuals who receive scholarship aid from this fund may reapply for further assistance in a subsequent year. This is a MERIT based scholarship. The S/G representatives will make the annual selections based upon students' portfolio submissions. Individuals will be selected without regard to gender, ethnicity, national origin, sexual orientation or disability.

A portfolio should consist of at least 8-12 pieces of your strongest work. If your work is digital and must be seen online, please provide a link.

Artwork should be mainly classroom assigned but you may include work you've done without teacher direction as well.

Art is judged on creativity, use of artistic principles, use of medium, successful execution of a concept and relation to your chosen major/minor.
